The Siberian cedar (also called Siberian pine, *Pinus sibirica*) is a majestic tree that lives to 550 years, grows to over 30 m (100') tall and covers over 100 million acres (more than 40 million ha) of the Siberian taiga (boreal forest). Famous for its exceptionally nutritious, healthful nuts (also called *pine nuts*), the Siberian cedar is a tree of unparalleled grace and beauty, a patriarch of the Eurasian forests.

It is also a tree of exceptional spiritual importance. The Siberian cedar has been a totemic tree of indigenous Siberian cultures for many millennia. In Russia, monks planted sacred Siberian cedar trees in monasteries and distributed cones and seeds to pilgrims for planting elsewhere. Ingredients: 3 cups basil leaves, 1/2 cup parsley, 1/2 cup cilantro, 1/3 cup olive oil, 1/3 cup pine nuts, 1/3 cup goat feta cheese.

Instructions: crush and blend all ingredients in a blender. Enjoy!



PINE NUT FRUIT SALAD

Ingredients: 1 carrot, 1 apple, 1 banana, 1 tbsp raisins, 1 tbsp pine nuts, 2 tsp pine nut oil.

Instructions: grate the carrot (with a large-calibre grater), slice the apple and banana, add raisins and pine nuts and mix everything in a salad bowl. Add pine nut oil and mix again. Serves 2. Prep. time 10 min.



SPROUTED RYE & PINE NUT BREAD WITH PINE NUT OIL

Ingredients: 1 cup rye berries, 1 cup pine nut flour, 2 tbsp pine nut oil.

Instructions: soak rye berries for 24 hrs, rinse, spread in a 1/2 inch layer on a plate and leave at room temperature to sprout. Rye usually sprouts within 12 to 24 hours. Put it in a blender, add water to cover the rye and blend at high speed until it becomes a homogenous thick liquid (add water as necessary). Add pine nut flour to the resulting dough. The ideal dough is similar in its thickness to sour cream. Put some dough on a medium-hot pan and spread with a spoon to form a small pancake 1/4 inch thick. Cook until the surface is dry, then turn over to bake the other side. Put on a plate and make more flat breads like this. Oil one side with pine nut oil (using a brush). Alternatively, pour the oil in a small bowl, roll the bread into a roll and dip into the oil while eating. Serves 4. Preparation time 45 min. Very high-energy food!
